

### III. Commitment to ingredients:

Among these Tokyo-grown ingredients, we at Tachibana Tenshinan use a variety of ingredients such as the mythical **"Yanagikubo Wheat Flour"** (now certified as an Edo Tokyo Vegetable) that has been produced in Higashikurume City since 1851 to preserve the origin of the wheat flour seeds, the rare Tokyo-grown wheat flour **"Sato no Sora"** that is not available on the market, **"Gambakun and Tamagokoro"** branded chicken eggs that are fresh and freshly laid in Akiruno City and Tachikawa City, which are produced near the factory, **"Tokyo Sayama Green Tea"** that is rare and highly valued and one of the three most famous teas in Japan for its flavor, **"Umi no Sei"**, a traditional Japanese sea salt made in the sun and in a flat pot on the mineral-rich and naturally rich Oshima off the coast of Izu Oshima, and Edo Tokyo vegetables that have been handed down since the Edo period, such as **"Naito Pumpkin and Naito Chili Pepper"** that were once grown around Shinjuku Gyoen National Garden. In addition, the rich oleic acid in the edible **"Camellia oil"** (scientific name: *Camellia japonica*), a product of which Japan is proud, produced in Izu Toshima Village, is said to have health benefits as well. We will continue to gather these Tokyo ingredients and create "delicious, new, and nostalgic" sweets. Not only are the main ingredients 100% domestic, but we also use ingredients from Tokyo and manufacture them in Tokyo. We are passionate about our mission to create real Tokyo products.
